QUMEA AND SYSTEMATIC JOIN FORCES TO ACCELERATE SAFER PATIENT CARE ACROSS EUROPE

Solothurn / Aarhus, 12 May 2026 – Swiss e-healthtech pioneer QUMEA and Danish healthcare software leader Systematic are joining forces in a strategic partnership set to reshape patient safety in the Nordics. Systematic will act as one of QUMEA's recommended integration partners for the Nordic region, combining Europe's most advanced privacy-preserving patient sensing with one of the region's most trusted clinical software platforms – and putting the Nordic healthcare market at the heart of the rollout.

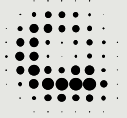
At the core of the partnership is a planned integration. The two companies intend to connect QUMEA's radar sensor – which detects falls, immobility and unusual movement patterns camera-free and anonymously – with Columna Flow, the clinical workflow platform used every day in hospitals across Denmark, Norway, Sweden and beyond. Columna Flow gives hospital teams a shared, real-time view of clinical and operational activity, replacing fragmented communication with coordinated workflows.

Once built, the integrated solution will turn continuous, privacy-preserving insight at the bedside into direct, actionable workflows for nursing and care teams – delivering safer patient flow, better use of staff time and more focus on direct patient care. For hospitals, geriatric clinics and long-term care providers, the value is clear: fewer falls, fewer night-time interruptions, better-targeted interventions and significant relief for nursing staff at a time of growing workforce shortages. In Denmark, QUMEA's exclusive sales partner Human Bytes will continue to lead commercial activities, with Systematic complementing this as the recommended integration partner.

For Nordic decision-makers, the partnership offers a rare combination – a clinically proven safety technology integrated by a partner they already trust and work with every day. At Västra Götalandsregionen (VGR) in Sweden, one of the country's largest healthcare regions, both QUMEA and Systematic solutions are already deployed independently – illustrating the potential that a future integration could unlock. Denmark, Norway, Sweden and Finland are among the most digitally mature healthcare markets in the world – and, at the same time, among those most affected by demographic pressure and staff shortages. By pairing QUMEA's movement detection layer with Systematic's deeply embedded Columna Flow platform,
